



# New BMS work

BMS World Mission has a long history of supporting individuals and communities as they wholly transform lives. While the gospel remains unchanged, we adapt to changing needs and continue to step into new work, guided by the Holy Spirit. Please join us in praying for our new work.

God has opened a door for BMS World Mission to support evangelism and church planting in Mongolia.



**MONDAY 19** Pray for BMS as we pilot new initiatives to integrate our disciple making movement work with our church and community mobilisation (CCM) work for a deeply integral expression of the gospel.

**TUESDAY 20** BMS is significantly expanding its work in CCM within our Hope for the World programme. Pray for BMS-supported worker Cuthbert and his CCM team in Malawi.

WEDNESDAY 21 Pray for communities in Rwanda and Burundi, where 35 new churches are participating in CCM. Pray also for CCM co-ordinators Jean Edouard (Rwanda) and Donatien and Archange (Burundi).
